



## Medication Donation Guidelines

Minnesota has a medication repository program, RoundtableRx, that accepts donations of safe, quality, unexpired medications and medical supplies and redistributes them to Minnesota patients in need!

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### What is acceptable to donate?

- Prescription-only and over-the-counter medicine and supplements
- New, unopened medicines in original manufacturer packaging
- Medicines that were bubble packed by a licensed pharmacy (pills must have identifying markings)
- Products with expiration dates of 6 months or greater
- New and unopened blood sugar testing supplies and insulin needles



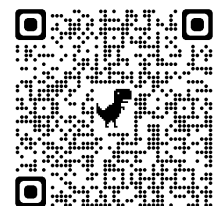
#### What cannot be donated?

- Opened, used or compromised medications and supplies
- Medications in amber vials
- Bubble packs with more than one medication per bubble or card
- Expired medications, or medications that expire in less than 6 months
- Medications requiring refrigeration or storage outside of room temperature
- Controlled substances (opioids, amphetamines, benzodiazepines, etc.)
- Medications requiring a REMS program for dispensing
- Select specialty medications (request clarification from RoundtableRx)



#### How do I donate medication?

Complete our [Donor Questionnaire](#) available on our website, or by scanning the QR code. After the questionnaire, you will then be asked to return a completed [Donor Form](#). Once the form and questionnaire is complete, additional information will be provided on our donation process. If you are unable to complete the [Donor Questionnaire](#) we can schedule a call with one of our pharmacists instead. Approved donations can be mailed or dropped off at our office in Minneapolis.



#### What happens to the medications after I donate them to RoundtableRx?

Donated medications are checked by a pharmacist for quality and safety, then distributed to our partner clinics and pharmacies. These clinics and pharmacies dispense the medications directly to uninsured or underinsured patients in Minnesota.
